A Call For Nominations

Nomination Deadline: The deadline for receiving nominations to the 2020 Hall of Fame is Monday, March 1st, 2022. The Awards Luncheon will be held at the Alabama Activity Center in Montgomery, on a Saturday in July, 2022.

The AHHOF induction and awards ceremony is held every other year when the 12 outstanding individuals are honored. The date for the 2020 Honoree Awards Luncheon has been cancelled. An alternative date in 2021, that is clear of COVID-19 limitations, will be chosen.

The deadline for nominating the 2022 honorees is March 1, 2022.**

Contributions by the nominee must distinguish them from the mainstream of others working in the same field. Nomination form should be accompanied by a letter from the nominator describing in detail the accomplishments of the nominee including education, positions held, appointments, and other significant and relevant information. The characteristics of the nominee in the areas of caring, scholarship, and/or dedication should be clearly identified in the nominator's letter.

A minimum of three and not more than five letters of support should accompany the nomination packet. Newspaper, magazine and other media information should not be included in the nomination materials, but may be referred to in the nominator's letter.

The nomination form must contain all relevant contact information and be submitted and signed by an individual nominator and not by an organization.
