

Call for Nominations Healthcare Hall of Fame Class of 2024

The Alabama Healthcare Hall of Fame was founded in 1997 with a purpose of recognizing those persons, living or deceased, who have made outstanding contributions to, or rendered exemplary service for healthcare in the state of Alabama. No other not-for-profit healthcare organization in the country honors a wide range of healthcare professionals including physicians, nurses, dentists, pharmacists, scientists, administrators, educators and related fields. It is this special camaraderie that has endeared the organization to thousands of professionals and family members.

The deadline for receiving nominations to the Class of 2024 is Monday, December 11, 2023.

The induction and awards ceremony is held every other year and customarily honors 12 outstanding individuals. The 2024 awards program is Saturday, August 10, 2024, at the RSA Activity Center in Montgomery.

The contributions by the nominee must distinguish him or her from the mainstream of others working in the field. The form should be accompanied by a letter describing accomplishments including education, positions held, appointments and other significant work. Characteristics of caring, scholarship, and/or dedication should be clearly identified.

A minimum of three, and not more than five, letters of support should be included in the packet. Newspaper, magazine and other media information can be referenced in the nominator's letter. Please include all relevant contact information and a signature by the nominator.
